Subject: Access Through Parks and Open Space

Pursuant to Section 13-1-2 (D) of the Westminster Municipal Code, the following Rules and Regulations are hereby established and deemed necessary for the orderly use and management of all Park and Recreation facilities.


The following is prohibited:

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorcycle, motor powered bike or scooter, all terrain vehicle, snowmobile or other vehicle device powered by an internal combustion engine within any City park property or other publicly held or controlled park, open space, or recreational property within the City of Westminster, except in areas specifically posted for such use or designated parking lots when used for that purpose or where such operation is specifically permitted by written order of the respective Director of Parks, Recreation and Libraries or his designated representative.

The term "Parks" includes all grounds, roadways, avenues, parks, open space areas, parking lots and areas and recreation facilities therein under the supervision of the Westminster Department of Parks, Recreation and Libraries; and all other publicly owned or operated park and recreation facilities within the City, including Standley Lake and the land around it (Standley Lake Recreation Area), the publicly owned areas of the Westminster Promenade, the property on which City Hall is located, and the property on which the public safety center is located.

Any defiance of these rules and regulations or any other in Title 13 of the City Code may result in criminal prosecution and/or an order prohibiting the offender from being in or upon the publicly-owned or maintained areas.
